

CITY OF CHADRON
SNOW REMOVAL PLAN

JURISDICTION: The City Street Department is responsible only for streets within the City Limits. As far as streets are concerned, this responsibility ends at the following locations:

Highway 20 East to Ridgeview Road (Wahlstrom Ford)
Highway 20 West to Stockade Road & (Greenwood Cemetery)
Highway 385 South to Sixteenth Street.
Ridgeview Road South to Sixteen Hundred Block.
Maple Street to Hidden Valley Road.
Sixteenth Street to Highway 385.
North Main Street to Bartlett Road.
Bartlett Road to Pine Street to the Motocross track.

The City does not get involved with snow and ice problems on private driveways, roads, and parking lots. We do, however, take care of the streets at the college, but no parking lots.

Prohibition of Parking on Snow Emergency Routes: By Ordinance NO. 1311 Resolution # 2008-44. The City Manager or the Public Work Director may order a parking prohibition on all snow emergency routes by declaring that an emergency exists on the basis of falling snow, sleet, freezing rain or other weather conditions making it necessary that parking on snow route be prohibited for snow plowing or other purposes. In such declaration the City Manager or the Public Work Director shall state the time that the emergency shall be in effect. It shall be unlawful for any person to park or allow to remain parked any vehicle on any portion of a snow emergency routes during a parking prohibition affecting such streets. Once in effect, the parking prohibition imposed under this section shall remain in effect until terminated by the City Manager or the Public Works Director. However, nothing in this section shall be construed to permit parking at any time or place where it is forbidden by any other provision of law. The Snow Emergency Routes:

Main Street – From 1st to 5th Street
Chadron Avenue - From 1st to 3rd Street
Morehead Street – From 2nd to 3rd Street
Second Street – From Bordeaux Street to Morehead Street
Third Street – From King to Mears Street

Sanding: Due to costs, we can neither clear the ice nor sand all streets. Generally, the public is aware of icy conditions and drive accordingly. We do attempt to keep high traffic and special hazard areas are shown on the map titled Ice Control Map. When these areas become unusually slick, please notify the Street Shop at 432-0528 or The Chadron Police Department at 432-0510. If a request for sand comes in for an area not on the map, we will appraise the situation and sand if a hazardous situation exists.

General Snow Removal: When cleaning your lot or drive it is better to pile snow on your grass or property rather than in the street. If at all possible, move your vehicle off the street until the snow plows have cleared your street.

Remember to always drive with caution, especially around sanding and snow removal equipment.

Commercial Snow Removal: If anyone is interested in removing snow for the citizens of The City of Chadron, contact city hall by calling 432-0505 or send a post card to P.O. box 390 Chadron Nebraska 69337. These companies will be kept on file and forwarded to people needing this service.

Snow Plowing Costs

Cost for 8 Hours of snow removal with 3 Trucks.....	\$2520.00
Cost for 8 Hours of snow removal with 2 Loaders.....	\$1672.00
Cost for 8 Hours of snow removal with 1 Motor Grader.....	\$920.00
Total cost:	\$5112.00

Sanding Costs

Cost of sand (per load).....	\$250.00
Cost of chemical (per load).....	\$40.00
Cost of truck (per hour).....	\$120.00
Cost for 4 hours of sanding intersections.....	\$1640.00

All costs are estimated and vary from snow storm to snow storm.
