

WATER/WASTEWATER SUPERINTENDENT – City of Chadron, Nebraska (6,000)

The City of Chadron, Nebraska is located in the heart of the Nebraska Pine Ridge and noted for hunting, fishing, and outdoor activities is seeking an enthusiastic and motivated individual for the position of Water/Wastewater Superintendent. This position is a working management position supervising the operation of the following: 4MGD Water treatment Plant, Wellfield Operations, Transmission Mains and Pump Stations, Water Distributions System, SCDA System, Wastewater Collection System, Wastewater Treatment Lagoons (aerobic), Municipal Swimming Pool, Utility Billing and Collections, and Snow Removal at the Municipal Airport. The minimum requirements for this position are four years of college majoring in Biology, Chemistry, or other similar environmental sciences, and three years responsible charge of a Public Water Supply; or, a High School Diploma and a minimum of six years of responsible charge of a Public Water System utilizing typical Surface Water Treatment techniques. All applicants must have a valid Drivers License and a current Grade 2 Nebraska Water Operator's License or the ability to obtain one within six months of employment. An appropriate Wastewater Treatment Certificate will be required upon completion of the new Mechanical Wastewater Treatment Facility. Preference will be given to those candidates with a current Nebraska Grade 1 or 2 Water Operator License, a Grade 6 (Backflow) certification, and recent surface water treatment experience. Pre-employment drug test and background check is required. Salary commensurate on qualifications.
