



GENERAL POLICIES

1. EVERYONE entering the facility has to have a pass or pay admission.
2. Members must scan their membership card and sign in to gain admittance to the Aquatic Center. NO CARD, NO ADMITTANCE. Replacing a lost card or requesting additional cards is \$5.00 per card.
3. Non-members desiring entrance to the Aquatic Center must pay the appropriate day fee and sign the day book.
4. Veterans/Seniors (55 & Older) discount is available upon request. The discount is only available for one or the other, not both. **Discounts are not eligible on Punch Cards or Daily Admissions.**
5. All attire worn in the Aquatic Center must be appropriate swim attire (designed specifically for a swimming pool). Inappropriate attire will not be allowed in the Aquatic Center.
6. To utilize the slides, no combs or foreign objects are allowed in pockets and no jewelry can be worn while riding the slide. No cut off jeans or swimwear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets or metal ornamentation; only approved swimsuits allowed.
7. Kickboards may be used under the supervision of an adult.
8. Lifejackets that are properly fitted and pool noodles are authorized for use, but pool noodles will not be allowed in the deep end.
9. The Therapy Pool is for physical therapy, rehab, and water aerobics ONLY, or at the manager's discretion.
10. Walkers on the Walking Track must stay on the outermost edge of the track. No walker is allowed to walk along the edge of the pool for the walker's safety.
11. The Aquatic Center is not responsible for personal articles lost or stolen at the Aquatic Center. We suggest you leave all valuables at home or be sure to lock them up while using the facility.
12. Lockers are available on a daily basis at no charge. Please use your own lock to secure your personal belongings and remove the lock at the end of the day. **Any lock that is left on a locker overnight is subject to be removed by the Aquatic Center staff.** With a current paid membership and additional lock rental fee paid, locks are allowed to remain on lockers. Locker number must be reported to the front desk.
13. The Aquatic Center is not responsible for any accidental injury to members or guests while participating in physical activities at our facility or in our programs.
14. The Aquatic Center is classified as a Drug Free Zone. Any type of drugs, tobacco, alcohol or controlled substances are prohibited and penalties for violations of this federal classification are doubled.

Administrative Policies

1. The Aquatic Center reserves the right to cancel any class or program due to insufficient registration, unavailability of instructors or loss of class space.
2. Cash refunds will not be made, except in cases where the Aquatic Center has cancelled classes/programs or the Aquatic Center receives written notification of the reason(s) the class cannot be attended before the first class session.

Youth Policies

1. Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult (age 13 years & older) at all times.
2. Supervision requires that the supervising person be with the child at all times. Supervisor/caregiver must pay to enter the facility and must be in the water within arms reach of the child.
3. Guests must abide by the following adult to child ratio guidelines:
 - Age 3 and under: 1 adult for every 1 child;
 - Age 4-6: 1 adult for every 3 children;
 - Age 7 and over: 1 adult for every 10 children
4. Swim pants/Little Swimmers must be worn by children that are not toilet trained.
5. The Aquatic Center has adopted a no-tolerance policy. The first behavior offense: fighting, stealing, sneaking into the Aquatic Center, blatant disrespect to others, foul language, etc., will cause the immediate removal from all Aquatic Center programs and facilities for up to six months. A meeting between the Aquatic Center staff, the offending youth and their parents is required for reinstatement to the Aquatic Center. A second offense after being reinstated will cause permanent exclusion from all Aquatic Center programs and facilities.
