

ORDINANCE NO. 1423

AN ORDINANCE to establish the amount of certain fees and taxes charged by the City of Chadron for various services including but not limited to Building and Use, Zoning, Library, Occupation Licensing, and Pet Licensing, Water, Sewer and Drainage Systems and Facilities of the City for Residential Users and Commercial Users (Including Industrial Users) of the City of Chadron for the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year, to provide for the repeal of conflicting ordinances; to provide for an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHADRON, NEBRASKA

NOTE: After hours is defined as work performed between the hours of 4 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Friday as well as any time on Saturdays, Sundays and all recognized holidays.

MISC:

Section 2. Fees not listed in the previous section are still valid and applicable as noted in their documents of origin to include but not limited to equipment rental fees.

Section 3. Bond amounts shall be set as per their respective ordinance or resolution.

Section 4. For fees which are required to be adopted by State Statute, this ordinance serves as an affirmation and shall not override the governing statute.

Section 5. Any City official is hereby authorized and directed to refuse service to anyone who refuses to pay the fee established for that service.

Section 6. The City of Chadron shall have the right to charge, in addition to the above fees, any overtime costs incurred in connection with the service.

Section 7. That any other ordinance or section passed and approved prior to the passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions is hereby repealed.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect October 1, 2021 and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
